| Pitch Booking   | Via Harpenden Colts booking pages – follow instructions on the web page. Please use the actual pitch booked (see Venue Map on final page for pitch references) and distribute use around the pitches to ensure pitches remain playable through the season. |
|   | Any cancellations must be removed from the Colts booking pages ASAP  |
|   | Snr 1 is available to book where indicated on the booking pages. 7v7 1&2 must only be booked where it is allowed on the booking pages. This is to ensure the pitches stay in good condition and that there is not parking congestion.                      |
|   | If you don't have booking rights to use the page – contact secretary@harpendencolts.com  |
| Earliest arrival and kick off   | In accordance with league rules  |
| Arrival at venue  | If yours is the first use of the pitch of the day - you will need to collect any equipment from the pavilion   |
| Storage   | Corner flags and respect lines are stored in the wooden building across the road from where cars are parked. The venue manager will supply the padlock code  |
| Parking   | You will be able to park in the designated parking bays across from the football pitches.  |
| Spectators  | Spectators welcome – but please put up a Respect Line and have spectators one side of the pitch, coaches the other side  |
| Dogs  | Dogs are not allowed on the pitches.   |
| Goals/nets/goal<br>weights  | Goals locked by the side of the pitch. Please return and lock these at the end of your session.  |
| Corner flags  | See storage details above  |
| Respect lines   | See storage details above  |
| Footwear  | Grass venue so moulded or metal studs  |



| Refreshments               | Available in Town Centre – multiple cafes and shops   |

| Toilets                    | There is a toilet available for use in the wooden building where our equipment is stored. The code for this is available from the venue manager |
| After your match           | If yours is the last match on the pitch, please return all equipment to the storage unit and make sure the padlock is locked.                   |

**Location of nearest Defibrillator** 

Defibrillator is mounted on the external wall of the clubhouse in the Rothamsted 3G pitch. The defibrillator is maintained and checked by the Town Council and registered with 'The Circut' so the emergency operator can issue the cabinet code to anyone requiring assistance during a medical emergency.
