Pitch Booking	Via Harpenden Colts online booking page. Please follow the KO times shown on the booking page strictly as these reflect our booked slots at the venue and there are other clubs using the pitch at other times.		
	If you don't have booking rights to use the page – contact secretary@harpendencolts.com		
Arrival at/departure from venue	Please check in with staff at the Reception Desk on arrival and prior to departing the venue. If the external gates are locked the access is gained through reception.		
	When checking in it is worth asking reception/security to open the gate which gives parents access to the far side of the pitch for viewing.		
Parking	As shown on the site plan		
Spectators	No spectators on the 3G pitch – only coaches, players and officials.		
	All spectators (for training and matches) to view from outside the fencing		
Dogs	None allowed on the school site other than service dogs		
Chewing gum	None allowed on site – please ask players to remove gum and dispose of in the bin if you see them chewing.		
5 Aside Pitches	There are no line markings for 5 aside pitches so please arrive in time to set up cones to mark pitches		
	Also note that the 11 aside goals do not fit into the recesses that were designed to take them, so it is not possible to safely use the goal line as a touch line for smaller pitches – resulting in further cones needed. If anyone can think of a way to resolve this issue then please let venue manager know.		



Goals/nets	Goals should be located on the pitch. Smaller goals can be moved to the recesses at the side of the pitch when not needed At the end of your session, please return all junior goals to the recesses designed for them. 11 aside goals can be left in their correct position on the pitch or in the recesses at the ends of the pitch.	
	If there is any damage to the nets, please do not try and mend them yourselves as this creates a health and safety risk. Please notify the school's staff at Reception if you find any problems with the goals or the pitch.	
Corner flags	Generally not used at this venue but if anyone feels they are necessary please contact Venue Manager.	
Respect lines	Not needed as spectators should be outside the fence	
Footwear	3G pitch – no blades or flat bottomed shoes – plastic or moulded studs only, metal studs are acceptable but not ideal	
Toilets	There are toilets available in the main building	
Snow instructions	In theory the pitch can be used when covered with light snow. But do not remove snow from the surface with brushes or use the brushing machines as this will damage the surface. The only recommended action to remove snow is by running on/using the surface if it is deemed safe to do so as that will help melt the surface covering of snow.	
Defibrillator	See risk assessment that follows	
End of session arrangements	School is responsible for end of season arrangements.	




